GROWING WITH DIMOCK

As a patient at The Dimock Center since she was 14 years old, Yolanda Brown, now a mother herself, brings her two sons to Dimock's Pediatric Department. When her oldest son, CJ, was having ongoing difficulty interacting and communicating with others in school, she knew she could turn to her pediatrician for help. Because of our integrated mental health and primary care services, CJ's pediatrician was able to quickly refer and schedule an appointment with a Dimock psychiatrist and figure out next steps for their family.

Dr. Michael Tang, Clinical Director of Behavioral Health Integration, Pediatrician and an Adult and Child Psychiatrist at Dimock, worked with Ms. Brown and CJ to ultimately diagnose him with Autism and ADHD. Together, Dr. Tang, Ms. Brown and other members of Dimock's behavioral health and pediatric team helped treat CJ for these disorders and connect him with testing and other needed services. CJ is now thriving in school and loves his regular visits with Dr. Tang and the Dimock team.
